Hello,

In the booklet called the 'Ordo,' (which tells us what prayers and readings and other things to use for every Mass throughout the year), it states "On the Epiphany, there is an ancient custom of announcing the dates of movable feasts for the coming year. This proclamation has been used in connection with the blessing and distribution of calendars." This year we were going to have calendars for parishioners, and we hoped to have them by Thanksgiving so people could start filling them in as appointments got scheduled, but as of today, December 26, I still haven't seen them. Hopefully we have them by Epiphany.



Anyways, instead of making a long proclamation at Mass, I figured I would print them here: (announcement from the USCCB)

Know, dear brethren (brothers and sisters), that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the **fifth** day of **March** will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the **twentieth** day of **April** you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the **first** day of **June** will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the **eighth** day of **June**, the feast of Pentecost.

On the **twenty-second** day of **June**, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the **thirtieth** day of **November**, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever.

Amen.

You might notice that really all of these days depend upon one day, Easter, from which you could calculate the others if you were willing to take the time. I included the introduction to the dates that can be made for the proclamation because I think, other than the fact of calendars, it gives the reason for this proclamation, that even though we are celebrating the Nativity, all of this is connected to the joy of the Resurrection. We celebrate God among us here, but look forward to being with Him in heaven.

### EPIPHANY HOME BLESSING



One interesting custom for Epiphany is for families to ask God's blessing on our own homes. The ritual calls for parents to mark, **with blessed chalk**, the main entrance door with the initials of the Magi and a code of the current year.

This year's mark will be **20 + C + M + B + 25**

The numbers stand for the year in which the blessing is inscribed (2025). The letters stand for the names traditionally given the Magi who found the Christ Child: **Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar**. They are also an abbreviation for the Latin blessing: *Christus mansionem benedicat*, or "Christ bless this dwelling." **Blessed chalk will be available after masses this weekend.**

Before the blessing, gather your family at the main entrance to your home. All make the sign of the cross.

Parent: **"Let us praise God, who fills our hearts and homes with peace. Blessed be God forever."**

Family: **"Blessed be God forever."**

Parent/Reader: (*reading from Sacred Scripture*) **"And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage."** *Matt 2:10-11*

Parent imparts the blessing: **"Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only begotten son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill them with the light of Christ, that their concern for others may reflect Your love. We ask this through Christ, our Lord."**

Family: **"Amen."**

Then the parent sprinkles holy water on those gathered and sprinkles it about the home.

- ◆ To help stabilize your blood pressure, drink lots of water (and minimize caffeine). Your body will lose about two cups of fluid during donation, so **being fully hydrated is important.**

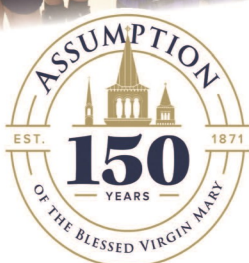
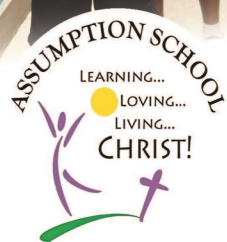

**Baptism: The church recommends that you have your child baptized as soon as you can,** so contact our parish office at 636-240-3721 and register for a baptism class.

**Wedding: Call the parish office at least 6 months prior to the wedding to begin preparations.** In addition to being sure that the church building is available for the date you desire, the Catholic Church also requires that a couple goes through certain preparation for the wedding, which should start at least 6 months prior to the wedding.

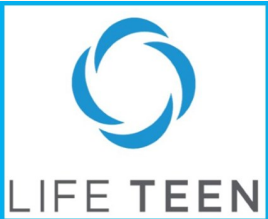
