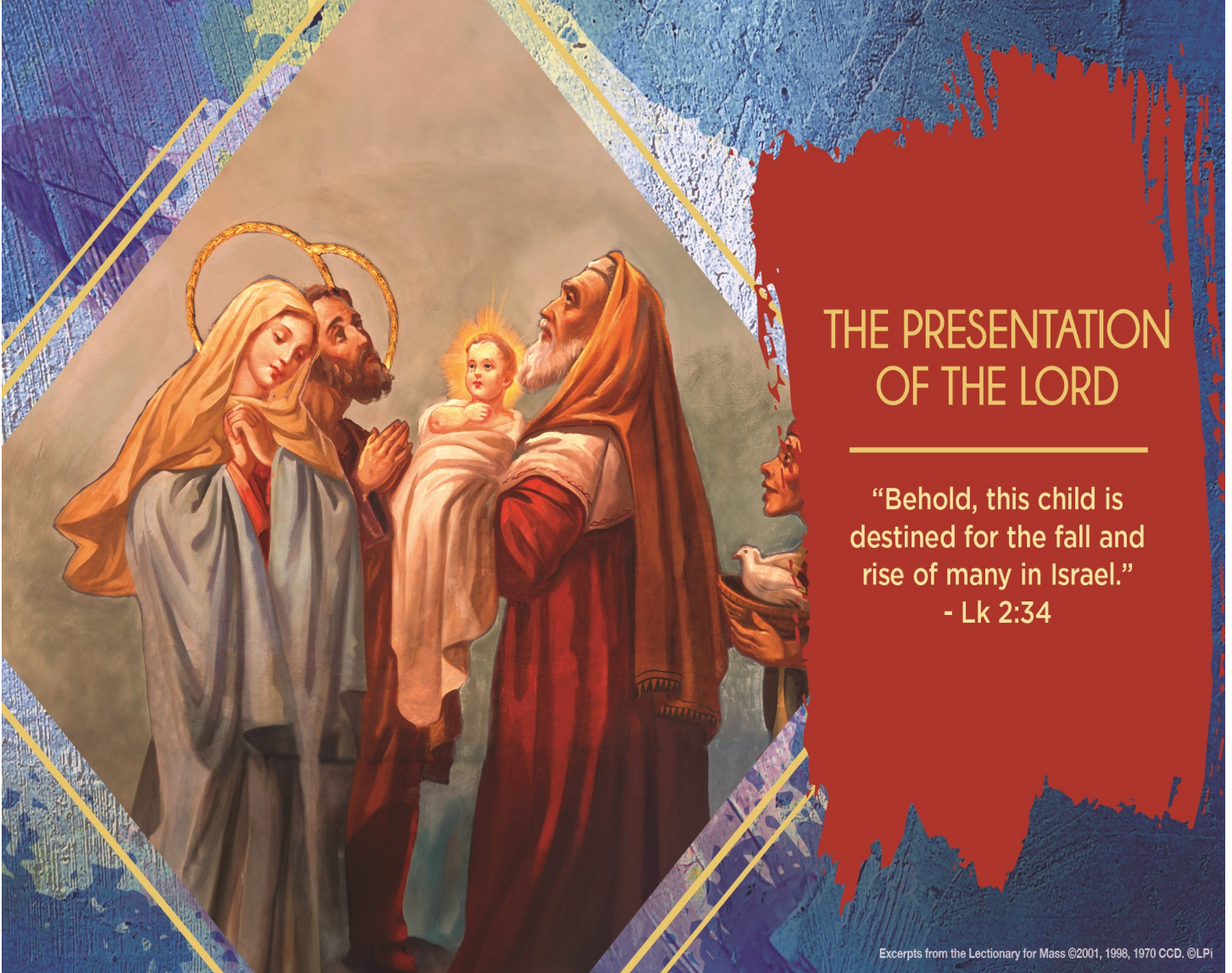

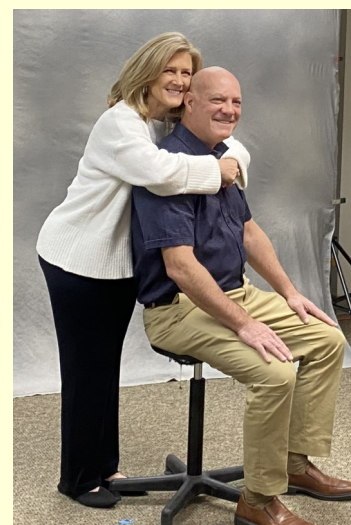

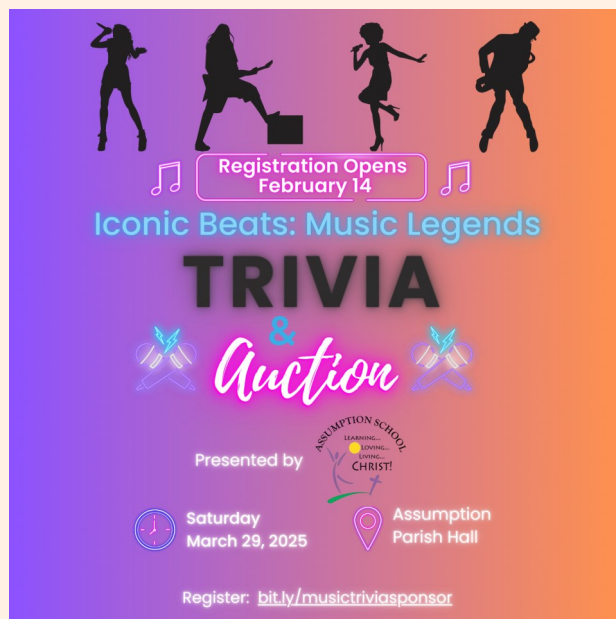

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS DURING FEBRUARY

As stewards of the monetary gifts that God has bestowed on us, we should give back to His Church and to other worthy causes. During the month of February, please support the general needs of the parish through the Sunday offertory, and consider the following specific causes and needs:

- ◆ **Education Fund:** Contributions to the Education Fund are used to provide tuition assistance to parents that want a Catholic education for their children but can't afford it.
- ◆ **St. Vincent de Paul:** Your contribution provides direct help to the poor in our local community. Since 1845, Vincentians have met face-to-face with individuals and families in poverty to provide support and help them through the most desperate times. Through your generosity, you help people struggling to survive, providing: clothing, shelter, food, medicine and more.
- ◆ **Assumption Building Fund:** Contributions to the Building Fund will help us pay for major maintenance and building improvement projects throughout our campus, including the Church, Chapel, and our school buildings.
- ◆ **Debt Reduction:** Donations to this collection will pay down the balance of Assumption's loan from the Archdiocese, which we borrowed in 2013 to fund the expansion of the school building.
